Re: Infringement of DRIPWRITER Trademark

Dear Mr. Fedorov:

This firm represents Dripwriter, LLC ("Dripwriter"), owner of common law trademark rights in the mark DRIPWRITER, used in connection with software as a service (SAAS) for text processing and formatting of user generated content, and the Trademark Application Serial No. 99/779938 for the mark DRIPWRITER, currently pending before the United States Patent and Trademark Office.

It has come to my client's attention that you own and operate the website www.dripwriter.org, through which you offer a browser extension operating within Google Docs that corrects typographical errors, false starts, and short pauses in user-generated text. A copy of the current website is attached for your reference. These services are identical or closely related to those offered by our client under the DRIPWRITER mark.

Your use of DRIPWRITER as the name of your domain, extension, and associated branding is confusingly similar to, and appears to be a deliberate adoption of our client's DRIPWRITER mark. Given the identical mark and closely related services, your use is likely to cause confusion among consumers as to the source of your services with our client.

Accordingly, on behalf of Dripwriter, we demand that you:

- 1) Cease all use of DRIPWRITER as a domain name, trademark, or in any branding, metadata, advertising, or marketing materials.

- 2) Transfer the domain www.dripwriter.org to Dripwriter, LLC, or, at a minimum, permanently disable and de-list it;
- 3) Rename or take down the GitHub repository located at <https://github.com/alexey-max-fedorov/dripwriter-origin>, and remove all references to DRIPWRITER from the repository name, README, source code and commit history to the extent practicable;
- 4) Remove the browser extension referencing DRIPWRITER from any browser extension marketplace or web store and cease all further distribution.
- 5) Provide written confirmation of your compliance with the foregoing to the undersigned.

We look forward to your prompt response.

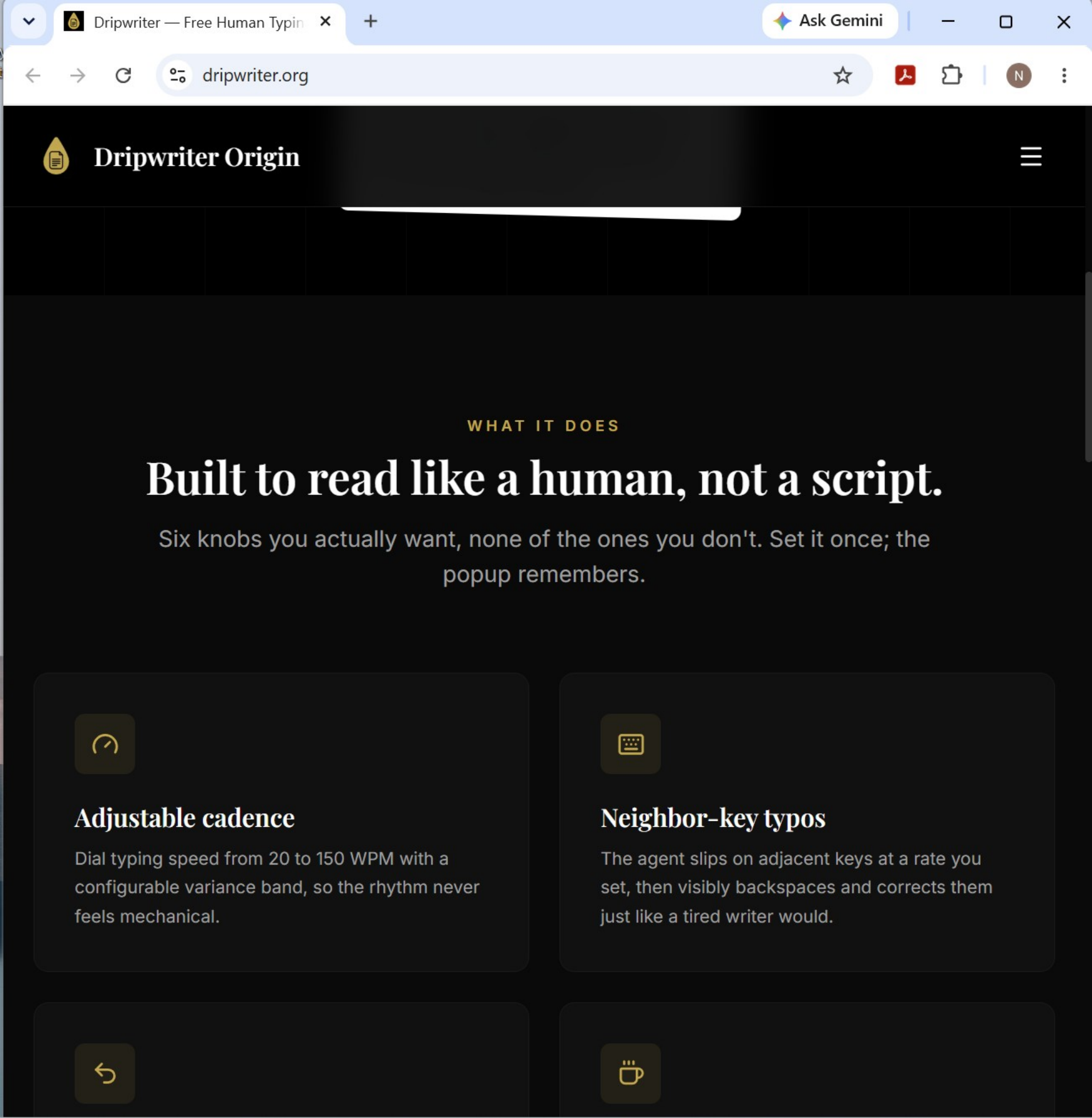

WHAT IT DOES

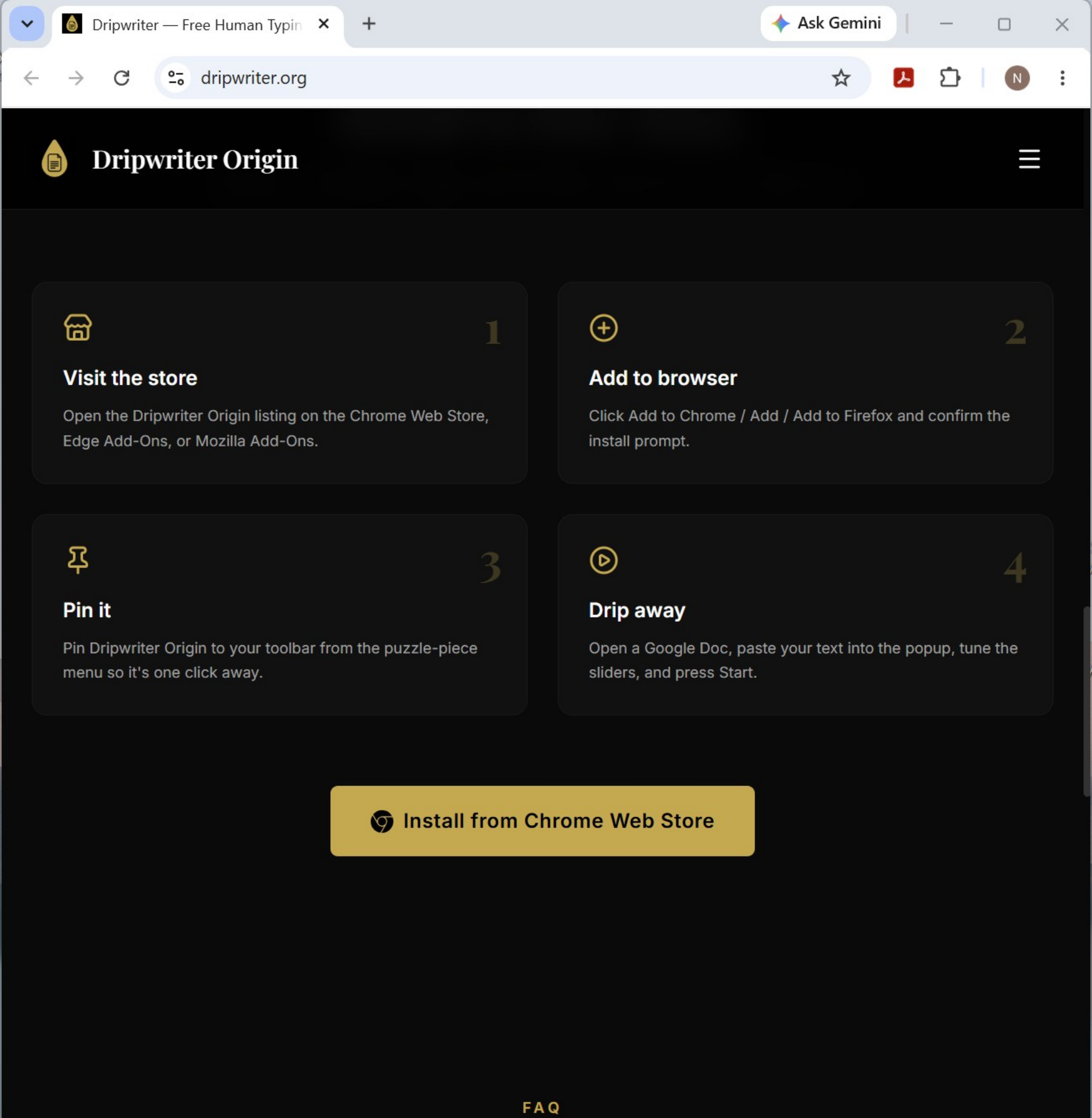
